The criteria for the Advocate for Inclusion and Belonging award is advocacy for inclusivity and belonging specifically within the CASE community.

Nomination packet shall include:

1. One statement (1000 words max) from the nominee or team, focusing on why their work may be worthy of recognition, based on the award's purpose. The statement may include
 - a. How the initiative demonstrated inclusivity and cultivated belonging within the CASE community
 - b. How the initiative uniquely addressed key issues of diversity and equity within the CASE community
 - c. How the initiative's success was measured, how it "moved the needle" in advocating for inclusion and belonging within the CASE community
2. Three supporting documents which may include any of the following
 - a. documentation related to the project,
 - b. supporting letters from colleagues or students who observed the work, have been impacted by, or benefitted from the work,
 - c. supporting letter from department chair (if the chair is not the nominator).
3. Signatures are required from the nominee, nominator, and chair.

Nomination packet should be in one PDF file.
Materials utilizing font size smaller than 12-point will not be accepted.
