- 2. One nominator letter (1000 words max)
- 3. Teaching statement (1000 words max) from the nominee, focusing on why they chose to implement their method and how it may have been successful.
- 4. Three supporting documents which may include any of the following:
 - a. a syllabus,
 - b. a detailed assignment,
 - c. examples of student work,
 - d. supporting letters from colleagues who have seen their approach (for example, Peer Evaluations of Teaching),
 - e. supporting letters from students or qualitative comments from SETs,
 - f. supporting letter from the department chair (if the chair is not the nominator).
- 5. Signatures are required from the nominee, nominator, and chair.

Nomination packet should be in one PDF file. Materials utilizing font size smaller than 12-point will not be accepted.
