




CASE Awards FY18-23 and FY24 YTD as of 4/8/2024

CASE Enrollment

- UG applications have increased by 74% compared to Fall 2021.
 - UG transfer applications up by 252% since Fall 2022.
 - Biology comprising 10% of the total FTC applicant pool. 3rd largest (777 FTC) behind only mechanical engineering and computer science (2023).
- GRAD applications have increased by 72% compared to Fall 2021.
- UG & Grad enrollment in 2024 are each down 5% compared to 2023.
- 30% increase compared to 2023 in terms of net deposits and yield.
 - 6 out of 9 departments have higher yield rates than in 2023.



Dean's Medal




