Distribution of College's Portion of Sponsored Research Indirect Recovery

The following policy is to be used to distribute the College portion of the indirect cost funds recovered from grant and contract expenditures. Beginning July 1, 2019 the College of Arts, Sciences, and Business receives 20% of the Facilities and Administrative (F&A) costs generated by grants in the College. (See Chancellor Policy Memorandum III-27 and III-30).

Distribution of the 20% College portion of indirect cost funds will be as follows:

College 56.25% Investigator 25.00% Department 18.75%

These percentages may be adjusted, in circumstances including but not limited to the following:

- If the College is unable to recover the (\$90,000) deficit created in exchanged for the 20% of F&A from Policy Memorandum III-27 dated July 1, 2019.
- If all, or a portion of projected F&A is committed by the College, Department, or Investigator for Cost Share Match.
